# TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR INDIVIDUAL CONSULTANTS

#### 1. Background/Rationale

India has the world's largest youth population, with over 300 million aged between 10 and 24 years. However, many young people lack opportunities to acquire the skills and mindset required for a rapidly changing world. To address this, UN ORGANISATION India through its YuWaah programme has embarked on a journey to support adolescents and youth in becoming a force for positive social and economic change through various initiatives.

UN ORGANISATION has a long history of innovating for children, focusing on providing life-saving information and services, engaging young people in change, and helping meet children's needs today and tomorrow. Innovation at UN ORGANISATION is about matching today's challenges with tomorrow's solutions, leveraging new approaches, partnerships, and technologies that support realizing children's rights.
